Don't Miss Out on Credits You Have Earned

The **Earned Income Tax Credit (EITC)** is a refundable credit for working low- and moderate-income individuals and couples, particularly those with children. Tax Year 2013 maximum credit is \$6,044.

The **Child Tax Credit (CTC)** is a tax credit that can increase the tax refund for families with children under age 17. For tax year 2013, the maximum credit is \$1,000 per qualifying child.
